Clockwise from top left, this page -

1. SW quoins, tower; note the Roman tooling on these reused stone blocks.
2. North face of tower.
3. Topmost window opening, tower, west face, note shaft mid-way in wall thickness.

Clockwise from top left, this page -

1. Chancel arch viewed from the nave.
2. Chancel arch, north capital viewed from the chancel.
3. Chancel arch north capital, from below. Possible re-use of Roman stonework (reuse of Roman stone detail being common and in this case possibly ex. the nearby Fishbourne Roman Palace).
4. Archway to tower, situated in east wall of tower, viewed from nave.
